ID-AYU0242) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 20 seats (instead of 24 seats) in 04 PG courses in the subject namely - (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana - 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (ii) Panchkarma - 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (iii) Rachna Sharir- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (iv) Kriya Sharir- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats), for the academic session 2023-24 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations there under-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11 th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely Himalayiya Ayurved Yoga Avam Prakartic Chikitsa Santhan Gram-Fatehpur Tanda, Jeevanwala Post-Via Doiwala Haridwar Uttarakhand - 248140 (Inst. ID-AYU0242) inspection of your College was conducted on 18.05.2023 \& 19.05.2023 on Hybrid mode as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process the Conditional Permission with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 24 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely - (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana -06 seats (ii) Panchkarma - 06 seats (iii) Rachna Sharir- 06 seats (iv) Kriya Sharir- 06 seats, for the academic session 2023-24 under Section 28 of NCISM ACT 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
2. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings:-
3. Teaching staffs
a) Availability of total teaching staff for existing PG courses in the subject are as under:-

(b) The college is not fulfilling the Student: Teacher Ratio in PG subject namely Rachna Sharir, Kriya Sharir, Dravyaguna, Panchkarma as per PG regulation 2016.
3. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the $\mathbf{4 2}^{\text {th }}$ Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 07.06.2023. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed therein as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of even no. dated $\mathbf{1 6 . 0 6}$. 2023 to appear on $\mathbf{2 1 . 0 6 . 2 0 2 3}$ before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to why not the conditional permission to your college with $\mathbf{6 0}$ seats in UG (BAMS) course and 24 seats in 04 PG courses in the subject namely - (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana - 06 seats (ii) Panchkarma - 06 seats (iii) Rachna Sharir- 06 seats (iv) Kriya Sharir- 06 seats, under section 28 of NCISM Act 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24 . The applicant college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions vide letter no. HAMC/2023/498 dated 19.06.2023 against the deficiencies conveyed to them.
4. Whereas, the college through its representatives, Principal Dr. Anil Kumar Jha and Dr. Nishant Associate professor appeared before the Hearing Committee on 21.06.2023 and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the proposed Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under:-

1. As per the notification dated $07^{\text {th }}$ November 2016 no. 4-90/2016-P.. Regulation no. 6(7) (8) the institute fulfils the requirement of additional teaching staff for PG course in the subject (i) Dravyaguna Vigyan (ii) Panchkarma(iii) Rachana Sharir (iv) Kriya Sharir

5. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The

Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine(NCISM), the recommendation of Hearing Committee was placed in the $44^{\text {th }}$ Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on 23.06.2023.
6. In view of the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and it is found that the college could not provide sufficient documents/evidence to substantiate the claims to fulfill the shortcomings as informed vide MARBISM letter. (Hearing notice) of even no. dated 16.06.2023. and board decided that the college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for Grant of Conditional Permission to Himalayiya Ayurved Yoga Avam Prakartic Chikitsa Santhan Gram-Fatehpur Tanda, Jeevanwala Post-Via Doiwala Haridwar Uttarakhand 248140 (Inst. ID-AYU0242) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 20 seats (instead of 24 seats) in 04 PG courses in the subject namely - (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana - 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (ii) Panchkarma - 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (iii) Rachna Sharir- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (iv) Kriya Sharir- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulation thereunder for the academic session 2023-24, due to the following reasons:-
a) The teacher-student ratio shall be such that the number of post-graduate teachers to the number of postgraduate students admitted per year is maintained as 1:3 in case of Professor and 1:2 in case of Reader or Associate Professor as per sub regulation 1 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016.
b) The teacher student ratio shall be 1:1 in case of Lecturer or Assistant Professor having minimum of five years teaching experience as per sub regulation 2 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016. However, as per the available faculty, college is not fulfilling the teacher: student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1.
7. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above, Conditional Permission is issued to the Himalayiya Ayurved Yoga Avam Prakartic Chikitsa Santhan Gram-Fatehpur Tanda, Jeevanwala Post-Via Doiwala Haridwar Uttarakhand - 248140 (Inst. ID-AYU0242) with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 20 seats (instead of 24 seats) in 04 PG courses in the subject namely - (i) Dravyaguna Vigyana - 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (ii) Panchkarma - 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (iii) Rachna Sharir- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) (iv) Kriya Sharir- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder for the academic session 2023-24.
(i) It is further informed that minimum $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$ of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of $\mathbf{6 0}$ seats and $\mathbf{1 5 \%}$ of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of $\mathbf{2 0}$ seats (instead of $\mathbf{2 4}$ seats) in 04 PG courses shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85\% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
8. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act \& Regulations thereunder.
9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31 st December, 2023 and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:
(i) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching \& training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
(ii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
(iii) All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
(iv) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
