- ✓ Title page should include them/title of article, full name of author(s) with designation, name of the institute, Email ID and contact number of corresponding author and maximum 6 keywords.
- ✓ Abstract/full paper should be in English language, type in MS word, Times new roman font, Font size 14 (Title) and 12 (for abstract) and line space 1.5.
- ✓ Word limit for abstract is 250-300 words and for full paper is 2000 words.
- ✓ For Abstract/article publication, the registration is mandatory (payment receipt to be attached to Google form)
- ✓ Abstract/full paper for publication will be selected by the scientific committee.
- ✓ Decision on selection and invitation for paper presentation will be sent separately to the candidates.
- ✓ Last date for Abstract / full paper submission - 28/07/2026.
